November 29: Launch of the new Millennial Railcard

The long-awaited 'Millennial Railcard' for 26 to 30-year-olds will be available to buy nationwide on 2nd January 2019. The new 26-30 Railcard will work in much the same way as its popular predecessor, the 16-25 Railcard, offering a third off rail fares for a fee of just £30 per year. The first digital-only railcard, it will be available for purchase online and downloaded to the Railcard app, so you can start travelling (and saving) straight away. It will entitle the user to a discount on Standard Anytime, Off-Peak, Super Off-Peak, and Advance fares on train services throughout Great Britain for travel outside peak hours (4:30 am to 10 am) Monday to Friday, and any time at weekends and on public holidays. The railcard could pay for itself after just three or four journeys.
